

## **East Shore Trail and H.R. 146 Sec. 1954**

Grand County's future hiking, biking and horse trails can be expanded!

Since the U.S. Congress passed the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 at the end of March, Headwaters is taking action to identify a line that would increase biking/hiking trail on the north-eastern shore of Lake Granby, connecting to the Grand Bay as well as Knight Ridge and East Shore Trails along Shadow Mtn. Reservoir.

HTA 's mission of linking towns with multi-use trails, has been working with the International Mountain Biking Association (IMBA) to design and flag a line that will be a sustainable trail.

Once the trail is officially routed and land agencies have had the chance to map their wildernesses, HTA's next step will be raising funds and seeking grants for an environmental assessment (EA), estimated around \$60,000.00-\$100,000.00.

HTA hopes to use the East Shore Trail as a connection to part of "Granby to Grand Lake Trail."

HTA's ultimate goal is to connect the future trail from Arapaho Bay on Lake Granby to the town of Granby.
